TRUE PROPHETS

In Deuteronomy today we hear that God's very words will fill the mouth of a true prophet, but a false prophet will, in a manner of speaking, put mere mortal words into God's mouth. In Mark's Gospel, we see Jesus teaching and healing as a true prophet, one filled with the authority of God's own voice, the Holy One of God. There are, no doubt, both false and true prophets around us today. The whole history of our church is filled with both. Some false prophets were extremely popular and quite well-versed in scripture, and even held positions of church authority. But in today's Gospel we learn that Jesus' fame spread because he taught with authority; he wasn't an authority because he was popular or famous. Elsewhere, we also learn from him, in his desert temptation confrontations with Satan, that anyone can quote scripture, even against God's purposes. Today we hear that his authority was not like that of the scribes, who held the official positions of religious authority in his day. Our work is to do our best to discern the true prophets in our midst, and to be true prophets as well. The psalmist tells us how to do this: by not hardening our hearts when God speaks. If we truly listen to God, it will be God's very words filling our mouths.



PROFETAS VERDADEROS

Hoy en Deuteronomio oímos que las palabras de Dios llenarán la boca de un profeta verdadero, pero un profeta falso pondrá, por así decirlo, palabras meramente humanas en boca de Dios. En el Evangelio según san Marcos, vemos a Jesús enseñando y curando como un profeta verdadero con la autoridad de la voz de Dios, el Santo de Dios. Sin duda, hoy existen profetas falsos y verdaderos a nuestro alrededor. La historia de nuestra Iglesia está llena de ambos tipos de profetas. Algunos profetas falsos fueron extremadamente populares y eran muy versados en la Sagrada Escritura, incluso ocupaban puestos de autoridad eclesial. Pero en el Evangelio de hoy descubrimos que la fama de Jesús se extendió porque enseñaba con autoridad; no era una autoridad porque fuera popular o famoso. En otra parte, descubrimos con él, cuando es tentado y enfrenta a Satanás en el desierto, que cualquiera puede citar la Sagrada Escritura para sus propósitos, incluso si estos van en contra de los de Dios. Hoy oímos que su autoridad no era como la de los escribas, que eran la autoridad oficial religiosa en su época. Nuestra tarea es hacer todo lo posible por saber identificar a los verdaderos profetas que están entre nosotros y también a ser verdaderos profetas. El salmista nos dice cómo hacerlo: no debemos endurecer nuestros corazones cuando escuchamos a Dios. Si realmente escuchamos a Dios, Dios pondrá sus palabras en nuestra boca..

News from the Padre / Noticias de Nuestro Sacerdote

The Catholic Bishops of the United States called a recent decision by the Obama Administration “unconscionable.” The Federal Department of Health and Human Services announced on January 20th that religious institutions would have a year before they would be required to make contraception available at no cost to all female employees. The repeated requests from Catholic bishops, Catholic Charities, Catholic hospitals, and Catholic schools for religious exemption to the bill’s requirement (that all health plans cover contraceptives and sterilization free of charge) has fallen on deaf ears.

In response, the president of the U.S. Catholic Bishops, Timothy Dolan of New York, said the administration had “drawn an unprecedented line in the sand.” “The Catholic bishops are committed to working with our fellow Americans to reform the law and change this unjust regulation,” he added. “We will continue to study all of the implications of this troubling decision. To force American citizens to choose between violating their consciences and forgoing their health care is literally unconscionable. It is as much an attack on access to health care as on religious freedom. Historically, this represents a challenge and a compromise of our religious liberty.”

Sister Carol Keehan, president and CEO of the Catholic Health Association, voiced her disappointment with the decision. She said the announcement was a “missed opportunity to be clear on appropriate conscience protection.” (*Catholic hospitals serve one out of six people who need hospital care.*)

“This is nothing less than a direct attack on religion and First Amendment rights,” said Sister Jane Marie Klein, chairperson of the board of the Franciscan Alliance, Inc., a system of 13 Catholic hospitals.

The bishops have a powerful argument that Catholic organizations are going to be “forced” to pay for something church teaching considers immoral. Even if Catholics are out of step with the majority of Americans, I don’t think it will matter. The bishops have effectively changed the topic of debate to “religious freedom.” This “contraceptive mandate” is the battle but it is “religious liberty” that is the war; especially with the elections coming.



A los Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos les llamó la atención la reciente decisión de la Administración Obama "inaceptable". El Departamento Federal de Salud y Servicios Humanos anunció el 20 de enero que a las instituciones religiosas se les da un año para que tengan la anticoncepción disponible sin costo para todas las mujeres. A las constantes peticiones de los obispos y las diferentes instituciones religiosas no están de acuerdo a la exigencia del proyecto de ley (que todos los planes de salud cubran los anticonceptivos y la esterilización de forma gratuita) ha caído en oídos sordos.

En respuesta, el presidente de los obispos católicos de EE.UU., Timothy Dolan de Nueva York, dijo que el gobierno había "dibujado una línea sin precedentes en la arena." "Los obispos católicos están comprometidos a trabajar con nuestros conciudadanos para reformar la ley y este cambio de regulación injusta", agregó. "Vamos a seguir estudiando todas las implicaciones de esta decisión preocupante. Están obligando a los ciudadanos estadounidenses a violar su conciencia y renunciar a su cuidado de salud, es literalmente inconcebible. Se trata tanto de un ataque en el acceso a los servicios de salud como a la libertad religiosa. Históricamente, esto representa un reto y un compromiso de nuestra libertad religiosa".

La Hermana Carol Keehan, presidenta de la CEO y la Asociación Católica de Salud, expresaron su decepción con la decisión. Ella dijo que el anuncio fue una "oportunidad perdida para ser claros en la protección de la conciencia adecuada." (Los hospitales católicos sirven a una de cada seis personas que necesitan atención médica.)

"Esto es nada menos que un ataque directo a la religión y a los derechos de la Primera Enmienda", dijo la hermana Marie Jane Klein, presidente de la junta directiva de la Alianza Franciscano Inc., es un sistema de 13 hospitales católicos.

Los obispos tienen un poderoso argumento de que las organizaciones católicas van a ser "obligadas" a pagar por las enseñanzas que la Iglesia considera inmorales. Incluso si los católicos están fuera de sintonía con la mayoría de los estadounidenses, yo no creo que les vaya a importar. Los obispos han cambiado el tema de debate a este "mandato de los anticonceptivos" es una batalla, pero se trata de "libertad religiosa", que es una guerra a "la libertad religiosa"; especialmente con las próximas elecciones.

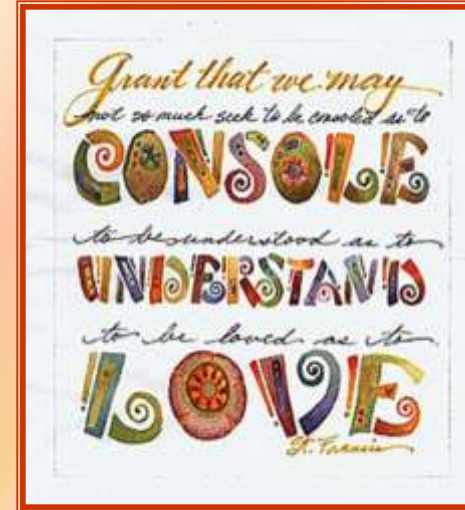
